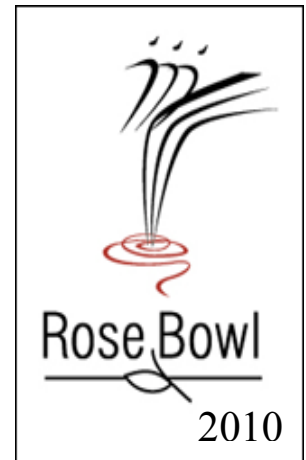


*27th Annual Rose Bowl
Synchronized Skating Competition
General Information*



Registration Procedures

Sign in your team at the registration desk located just inside the main entrance of the Max Bell #1, prior to your practice ice time. Onsite registration on Sunday January 17th must be completed no later than am, at the skaters' entrance in Max Bell #2.

If you are providing birth certificates at the onsite registration, please make sure that you arrive at least 1 hour before your scheduled practice time. The paper copies need to be checked before you are officially registered.

Please provide two (2) CD's of each program that are clearly marked with the team name, category, and length of the program. The team manager will be responsible for signing in the music at registration and signing out the CDs after the competition. In addition, we would also appreciate if you could mark which one is for competition and which one is the back-up. Thank you!

Admittance to the Arena

Upon registration, the competitors and two (2) team managers will receive their identification ribbons for free admittance.

Coaches are asked to wear their accreditation at all times.

On Sunday, January 17th, teams and team personnel should use the skater's entrance through Max Bell #2. Identification will be checked.

Parents and friends accompanying the teams will be required to pay at the door to Max Bell #1.

Entrance fee: \$8 Adults/Children 12 & up, \$5 Children 3-11, Children under 3 Free. All tickets are rush seating. Parking is free, and there is ample room for buses.

Photographs

A photographer has been commissioned to take team pictures after each team competes. A proof will be forwarded to you so that you may purchase copies.

NO flash photography is permitted by spectators during the competition.

Videotaping

This will be allowed from the upper concourse walkway only – not from the stands.

Boutique

Programs, pins and boutique items will be available for sale on Saturday and Sunday. Please note that CASH ONLY will be accepted for boutique purchases.

Competition Results

Results will be posted as soon as they are available. One complimentary protocol will be available to your team manager at the registration desk after the day's competition and awards as they sign out the music.

Off-Ice Practice Area

There is no official off-ice practice room for the event. If teams choose to practice in the main concourse, they must ensure that they are not interfering with public access nor playing music at a volume that interferes with the practice or competition skates.

Please be aware: Max Bell #2 is NOT AVAILABLE for off-ice practice.

Ice Sweeps

Rose Bowl will provide ice sweeps to sweep the ice surface for debris following the Beginner I and II, Elementary and Juvenile teams. All other teams are expected to provide their own sweeps. Your team may provide up to four (4) skaters to sweep the ice. Teams can use alternate skaters or up to four skaters lined up to enter the ice surface. Please inform the Ice Captain as to whom these skaters are.

Concession

Various food and beverages will be on sale at the arena concession during practice ice times and the competition. Teams are requested not to set up food tables anywhere on the concourse level, lower level, or in the stands.

Emergency First Aid

First Aid personnel will be available at rink side during all ice times.

Safety

Emergency Evacuation Procedures will be provided upon team check-in at the event. Please make sure you review it immediately.
